# **Onboarding**

You will be set up on our platform epaPRO, and provided with training to use the system and our resources.

## Registration

You register your apprentices on epaPRO with predicted "ready for EPA" date.

#### **Gateway**

You submit the required documents for Gateway on epaPRO.

### **Gateway Review**

The allocated End-Point Assessor reviews the Gateway documents submitted on epaPRO. We invoice monthly for Gateways accepted in the previous month.

# **Planning Meeting**

The apprentice and their manager call our Central Bookings team at the confirmed time. The Planning Meeting gives an opportunity to ask questions on End-Point Assessment.

#### Confirmation of Assessment

During the Planning Meeting, the assessment dates will be agreed, booked on epaPRO, and confirmation e-mails are sent out.

#### **EPA**

End-Point Assessment is carried out as previously agreed.

#### **Assessment Results**

Assessment Results are published on epaPRO for the Provider to view and pass on to the apprentice and employer.

## Re-sits

If any assessments are failed, the re-sits will be agreed with the End-Point Assessor directly. Re-takes, if needed, are managed through our Compliance team.
